## Important Dates to Remember

### April 14, 2022:

- In-Office Deadline for all Entries / Classes.
- Deadline to order stalls and pre-order bedding.

### April 21, 2022:

- Last day to scratch Limited Age Event classes and receive partial refund.
- Last day to scratch Spectaculars and receive full refund.

### April 23, 2022:

- Draw date for all Derby Herd Work
- Draw date for all Spectacular Herd Work.

### April 26, 2021:

- **Move In starts 1:00 pm – available until 8 pm**
- All other days throughout the show, horses may only arrive between 8 am and 8 pm daily – NO EXCEPTIONS.

### May 2, 2021:

- Move out must be complete by 10:00 am

# General Information

**REQUIRED HEALTH DOCUMENTS** – To comply with Facility animal health regulations, ALL horses will require a negative Coggins (Equine Infectious Anemia) dated within 12 months and all out of state horses need a health certificate dated within 10 days. All horses must have their health certificates and Coggins papers checked as you check in at the gate. Trailers containing horses without required paperwork WILL NOT be allowed onto the grounds.

**MOVE IN** - Horses may move in Tuesday, April 26 starting at 1 pm. Tri-State Expo is a secured facility and has very specific procedures and hours for accepting horses for move in. Horses will be accepted 8am-8pm daily NO EXCEPTIONS.

**MOVE OUT** – Move out must be completed by 10am, Monday, May 2nd.

## **SHOW OFFICE HOURS**

The show office will be open 1pm – 9pm on move in day. The show office will open at 6am on show days and close after the last class ends. The show office will NOT be open on Monday, May 2.

**TRAILER PARKING** – Once you have unloaded, security will give you instructions on trailer parking on the grounds. No trailer parking allowed in the ANC or Kimble lots.

**PAYMENT INFORMATION** - You will need to bring one open check or credit card for Horse Show Office when checking in. In the event that no charges are incurred during the event, your check will be returned to you. Any practice pen charges will be added to your show tab, separate payment is not required at the practice pen.

STALLS/RV/Bedding- Order by April 14th via OpenStalls.com. Be sure to make a "special request" to request stall with, stallion, etc. Additional stalls/shavings/rv nights added on site need to be paid via check made to Tri-State Expo.

Any stalls ordered after April 14th are not guaranteed that they will be stalled with their requested party. The stalls are 10'x10' steel stalls. They have solid walls between them. The floor of the stall is asphalt. Panels in the stalls may not be removed. A stall list will be posted online on the HDC website approximately one week before move in. Please verify your stall count is correct and contact the office with any corrections. This online stall chart is not final until it is listed as the final chart (usually one day before move in). Canceled stalls need to be verified by the HDC office for a refund. When you check in to the show office on arrival, notify the office of any canceled stalls. You will be charged for any stalls you did not have the office verify. Please do not bring refrigerators into the stall area.

**BEDDING** – Bedding must be purchased from the Show Office. (No outside bedding allowed). We request that you pre-order bedding to expedite move-in. The cost for shavings is \$11/bag. Separate payment is needed for the bedding office. Their hours are 8am – 5pm daily.

**DAY FEES** – If you haul in and are working out of your trailer and don't need a stall, there is a day fee of \$25 per day, per horse.

**PRACTICE PEN** – A schedule will be posted at the show. It will be run as a Priority Works pen the same day the class shows. Other works can be worked in after the priority works for that set have been completed. You will not need separate payment for the practice pen.

**WARM UP ARENAS** – The ANC will have open riding each day after the show is complete for 1 hour and open at 6am each day. All other show and warm up arenas will be open 24 hours a day with the exception of when being used for show classes.

**ENTRY INFORMATION** – All entries and stall reservations are due April 14, 2021. All entries must be paid in full to be included in the draw. This is an in-office deadline. You can complete online, mail, or email your completed entries to the HDC office. We will not process your entry without a form of payment! You have several options for payment:

- You may include a check with your entry form for the full amount.
- You may include credit card information for us to charge your card. Please be aware that there is a 3.5% processing fee on credit cards. You MUST include all information requested in order for us to process your card.
- You may include credit card information to process your entry but then replace that with a check once you arrive at the grounds. Please be aware that if you scratch your entry, we reserve the right to charge your card for any fees due. An entry verification list will be posted on the HDC website approximately one week before the draw. Please be sure to check your entries.

**LATE FEES** - Late fees will be charged to any entry received after the due date. Late fees are not charged to add classes or divisions to the original entry that was on time, for that horse.

**DRAW DATE** – The draw date for the Derby and Spectacular Herd Work will be April 23, 2022. Horse Show classes are drawn after noon the day before the class shows.

**DOGS** – Absolutely no dogs are allowed in the ANC. Dogs are allowed otherwise ON LEASH. Dogs creating a nuisance will be asked to be removed from the grounds.

**SIGNS, POSTERS & FLIERS** – Cork boards are available in the facility. No tape may be used on painted surfaces. Please use the non-stick command strips or sticky tack that does not damage walls. Thumb tacks are acceptable. Do not post to walls or doors in the facility!

**VIDEO:** National Sports Broadcasting is our official videographer. There will be a live webcast and all competitors can gain free access to their video courtesy of Heritage Days Classic by visiting the videographer's booth and filling out a form. You must visit the booth during the event to get free access to your videos.

**PHOTOGRAPHER:** High Cotton Promotions is our official photographer. Photos can be purchased at the photo booth or online at HighCottonPromotions.com.

**MEDIA PASS:** Media passes are for reputable publication use only. Contact the HDC Office for details. Anyone without appropriate credentials may be asked to leave.

## **Limited Age Event (LAE) Rules and Guidelines**

- This is a derby for 4 and 5 year olds to be shown in a snaffle or hackamore. Horses may not switch headgear within the competition. In the Non Pro Boxing Derby, 6 year olds may only be shown in a snaffle.
- The Non Pro Boxing division follows the same rules as the Horse Show Non Pro Boxing eligibility (see Rule 10.4.11).
- The NRCHA Rule Book contains the rules for Limited Age Events and will be followed as printed.
- Both owner and rider must be current 2022 NRCHA members.
- Limited Age Event Refund Policy – Scratches must be made in writing and received in the HDC office:
  - Scratches made on or before the due date → full refund of all fees
  - Scratches made after the due date but before the draw → refund of all fees minus 30% retainage
  - Scratches made after the draw → video and NRCHA fees only

# Spectacular and Horse Show Rules and Guidelines

## Spectacular Information, Rules and Guidelines

- Draw date for the Herd Work will be April 23, 2022.
- Any Spectacular Class entry scratches made before the Herd Work draw date receive a full refund. Spectacular scratches after the Herd Work draw date will only be refunded the video and NRCHA fees.

## Horse Show Information, Rules and Guidelines

- Added money & entry fees vary by class. Please see the chart below.
- Horse show class scratches made before the draw will receive a full refund. Horse show class scratches after the draw date will only be refunded the video and NRCHA fees.

**Spectaculars and Horse show class fees do not include video charges or NRCHA or AQHA fees. Please add on your entry form.**

**Cattle Charges** – Pay one cattle charge if classes entered run concurrent.

**Video Fees** – pay only one video fee if classes entered run concurrent.

Spectacular / LAE - \$30

Horse Show Classes - \$20

**NRCHA Fees** - \$8/division

**AQHA Fee** - \$8 / AQHA day/judge
